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2021 Spectator Guidelines for Bridgeport Recreation Complex

In response to the Covid-19 Pandemic, the following guidelines will be in place for games and practices at the Bridgeport Recreation Complex for the 2021 season.

These policies will replace the guidelines from 2020 and be effective Friday, April 16, 2021.

In response to the many factors, including the open-air outdoor nature of the facility and the availability of vaccines, the City of Bridgeport will be requiring the following guidelines for players and spectators at the Bridgeport Recreation Complex:

- All spectators should follow best social distancing practices stay six feet away from individuals outside their household; wear a cloth face covering; avoid direct hand or other contact with players/managers/coaches during play.
- Bleachers will be marked to assist in social distancing
- Masks will be encouraged but not required in the spectator areas.
- Encourage the use of masks for players sharing a dug out. Grass areas, bull pens and/or bleachers can be used to spread out players in the dug outs.
- Masks will be required for anyone entering the press box building including Concessions, Press Box and Restrooms.
- Water Fountains will not be operable.
- A spectator, player or coach with any of the following conditions should not attend a practice or game until evaluated by a medical provider and given clearance to do so:
 - Active COVID-19 infection
 - Known direct contact with an individual testing positive for COVID-19
 - o Fever
 - o Cough

Appropriate Signage will be place around the facility

These guidelines are subject to change due to changing conditions or mandates from State Health Department or the Governor.

Note: these guidelines will be considered the minimum required. Leagues and Organizers have the right to require more stringent guidelines based on their governing bodies requirements or personal or board driven directives.
